The areas shaded in blue are Flood Prone Areas as determined by The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

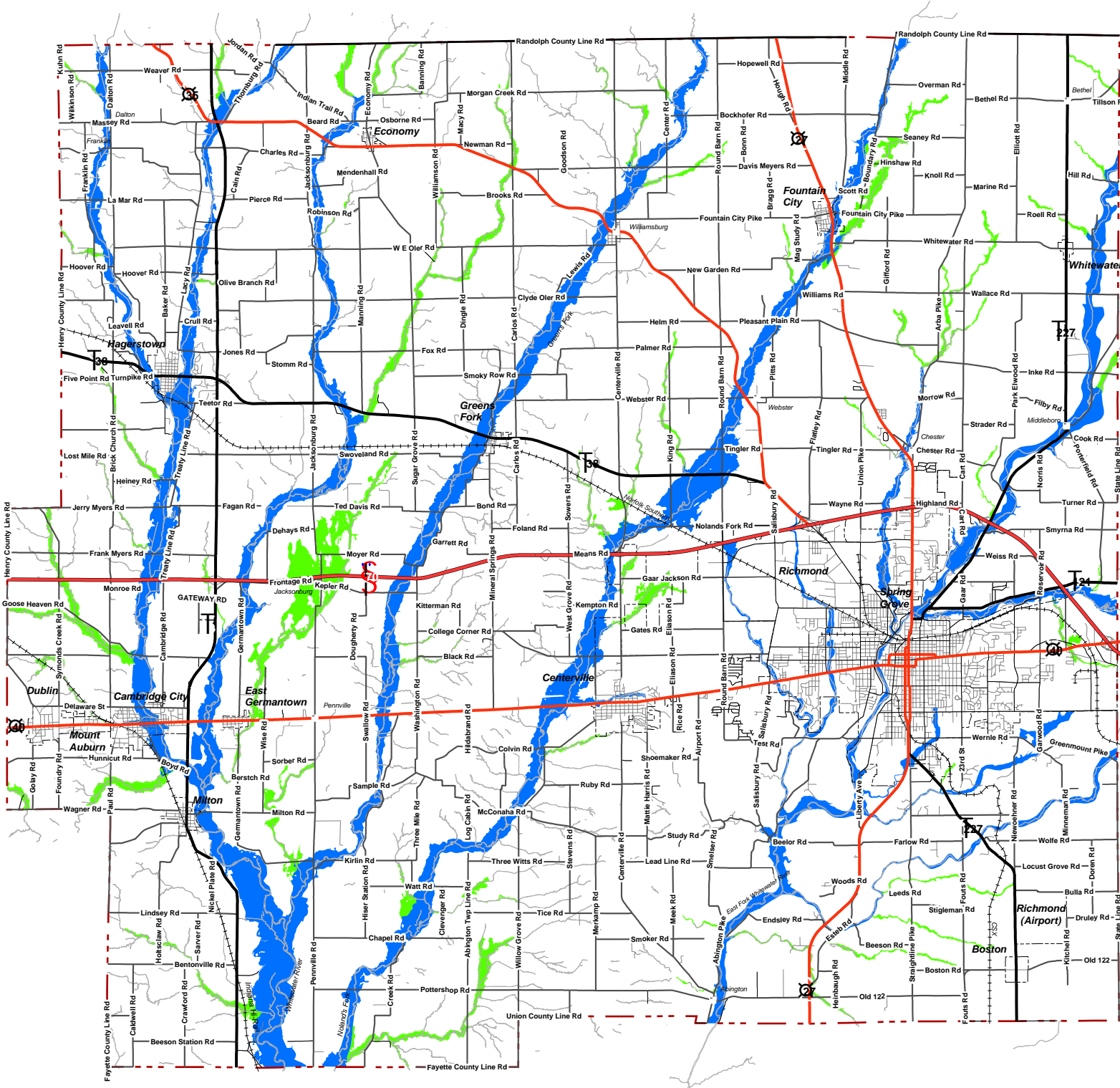
The Indiana Department of Natural Resources - Division of Water (IDNR) has developed their own flood zone map and the additional flood prone areas are highlighted green
